A typical 300-watt solar panel is 65.8 inches long and 36.1 inches wide. It takes up 16.5 sq ft of area.

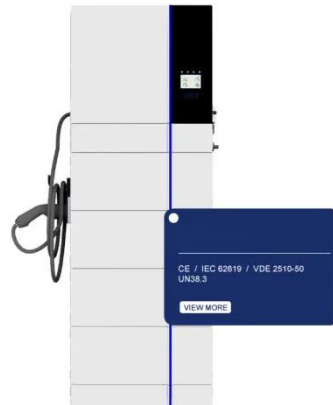
