Overview

Why did Libtelco change its name to LTC Mobile?

In October 2020, after the Liberian legislature amended the 2007 Telecommunications Law, the Liberia Telecommunications Authority (LTA) granted Libtelco a license to offer GSM mobile network services. Libtelco has now been rebranded to LTC Mobile. LTC Mobile competes with the existing private service providers to provide mobile voice and data services.

What is the telecommunications sector in Liberia?

The telecommunications sector in Liberia is active and competitive, with two main players: Lonestar Cell MTN and Orange Liberia. Both are global system for mobile communications (GSM) network operators that invest in network infrastructure and services.

How many mobile connections are there in Liberia 2021?

According to a Digital Liberia 2021 report, there were 3.39 million mobile connections in Liberia in 2021. This represents an increase of 19,000, or 0.6 percent, compared to the previous year.

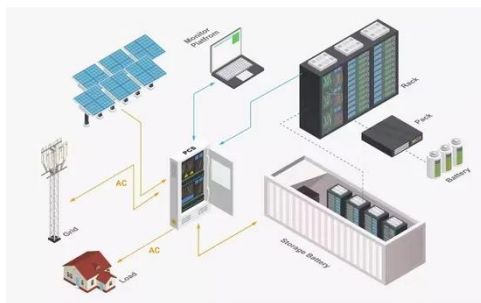
