Overview

Is there a solar project in the Philippines?

Given the limited scale of solar in the Philippines, it is perhaps surprising that there are plans to develop one of the world's biggest combined PV and energy storage projects in the country.

What is solar energy in the Philippines?

Solar energy is heat and radiant light from the Sun that can be harnessed with technologies such as solar power (used to generate electricity) and solar thermal energy (used for applications such as water heating). The Philippines Solar Energy Market is segmented by technology.




