Overview

Why is Asmara a modern city?

With massive investment to support Italy's war effort in the 1930s, Asmara became one of the most modern cities in Africa, with a population around 100,000 (including 50,000 Italians), 50,000 cars, more traffic lights than Rome, nine cinemas, and modern connections to the coast by road, rail and the world's longest cable car (75km).

Why is Asmara a UNESCO World Heritage Site?

Indeed, it was these attributes, embodied in the city's famed modernist urban architecture and planning, that earned Asmara the prestigious title of UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2017, a first for Eritrea and a first for modernist heritage in Africa.

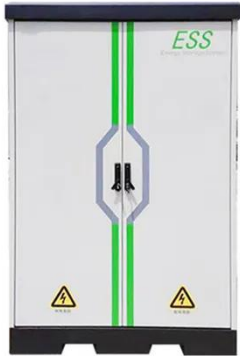
Is Asmara a pedestrian-friendly city?

Nothing attests to Asmara's pedestrian-friendly character more perfectly than the daily passeggiata when, every evening around 6pm, Asmarans flock downtown to the palm-lined main street, Harnet (Liberty) Avenue, to revel in each other's company and to simply be. Explore.

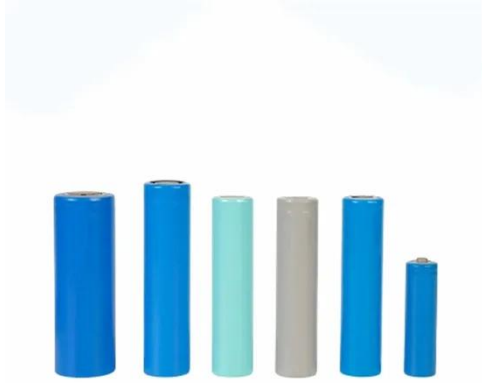
